



A Wildcard can be used with Varchar2s only and allows the User to specify a part of the value which should be filtered on, for example when searching an Address column the User could specify the Posttown and not the rest of the Address.

The key word used in a Wildcard is *LIKE*, this must be used with the wildcard symbol of '%', this signifies a character or characters of no significance in the search.

The '%' character can be used as many times as is needed within the search.



All Surnames beginning with 'W'

```
Filter: c65_member_surname like 'W%'
```

All Surnames ending with 'T'

```
Filter: c65_member_surname like '%T'
```

All Surnames with an 'A' within it (contains)

```
Filter: c65_member_surname like '%A%'
```
