8.1 Create a new Business Area which consists of Employee_Details, Location_Type and Store_Locations table, call the Business Area 'Store Employees'.

8.2 Create a new Folder and place the following items from the above Folders in it

Location Type

Location Description

Store Locations

Location Name

Location Address

Location Telephone

Employee Details

Employee Name

Employee Sex

Employee Manager

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8.3 Call the New Folder, Store Employees and make sure that it is only this Folder in the Business Area that the Discoverer Users can select.

8.4 Create a new Workbook in Discoverer 9i Desktop and select the Store Employees Business Area, make sure that the data isn't duplicated and that no other Folders can be selected other than the Complex one.

8.5 Export the Business Area as EX8_5.eex.

8.6 This exercise is going to create a Business Area with a Custom Folder alone, create a new Business Area.... Name the Business Area as Custom Employees

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8.7 Create a Custom Folder which selects ed_employee_name, ed_employee_sex, ed_employee_manager from the employee_details table, lt_location_description from location_type and sl_location_name, sl_location_address, sl_location_telephone from the store_locations table. Remembering to include the foreign keys to prevent duplicate records appearing.

8.8 Amend the Items created in the Custom Folder to make their titles more 'user friendly' in the name and description properties or alternatively amend the SQL to create aliases.

8.9 Create a new Workbook based on the Custom Employees Business Area

8.10 Export the Business area as EX8_10.eex.
