10.1 Create a new PHP file which will echo today's date plus 10 days, perform the 'echoing' in a function called 'display\_date' within the file, this will be called by the main body of the processing. Save as c:\course\ex10\_1.php

*Ten days time the date will be 04-01-2019*

10.2 Amend the previous processing so that the display\_date function 'returns' the date and the main body of the php file performs the printing. Save as c:\course\ex10\_2.php. The output should be identical to the previous example.

10.3 Change the previous process so that the main process passes as a parameter the number of days to be added/subtracted from today's date. display\_date() should be using a global variable, in other words, there is no need for a return. Change the output to reflect the new flexibility of the processing. Save as c:\course\ex10\_3.php

*10 days time the date will be 04-01-2019*
